



## Face Sneeze Shield Assembly

For any task that cannot be completed within the social distance guidelines of 2m (determined by a risk assessment), a face sneeze shield is an option that could be used as part of the required PPE. This face sneeze shield is compatible with our standard JSP helmets.

This shield **must not** be used for any abrasive wheel impact/chemical related activities etc., as this visor does not afford any impact rating under EN166B standard.

### Step 1

Lay out components onto a clean surface



### Step 2

Fold in sides of tabs as shown  
insert into slots on sides of helmet



## Step 3

Once tab is slotted through, open tab and slot down onto helmet edge to secure



## Step 4

Wrap shield around front of helmet, ensuring peak is slotted through slot on top of shield. Secure tab on opposite side, using same steps as previous



## Step 5

Completed hard hat shield



## Step 6

Wear the hard hat as normal with face sneeze shield attached



The face sneeze shield now attached to the hardhat acts as a physical airborne barrier between colleagues. Both the hardhat and visor must be cleaned and disinfected regularly.
